Impact Award

Impact real estate related projects substantially completed during January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024.

The Impact Award will be presented to a project or corporate initiative showcasing excellence, innovation and substantial impact in integrating sustainable considerations within project delivery, corporate strategy or stakeholder engagement, with measurable outcomes.

Submissions should focus on showcasing the most significant aspects of the project, including outcomes, metrics (including financial impacts), and what sets it apart from recent projects or current industry best practices. Specificity is key and point form is acceptable.

The submission should cover the following 3 elements:

- An overview of the project or corporate initiative.
- Details regarding the required work effort and resulting outcomes.
- A description of how the project showcases innovation and promotes positive sustainable impact, contributing to leadership within the real estate industry.

Four (4) key judging criteria include: Project Impact & Performance (40%), Innovation & Creativity (25%), Scalability (25%) and Other (10%).

Examples: This may include new sustainable development / redevelopment projects, building retrofits, corporate sustainability initiatives or programs, contributions to the sustainable building movement, social impact, and a wide range of other possibilities.
